

Nanopublication – Photobook publisher Steidl faces insolvency as unpaid wages spark labor-court claims

PROPOSITIONAL GRID [2]

Read this grid. “Not evaluated” does **not** mean the source has nothing to say about that proposition. It means **the reading did not instruct it**. That is not a result, and it counts in no denominator. A silence, by contrast, is a finding: the reading touched the proposition without concluding, or noted its absence itself.

FIRST PASS – KEPT AS WRITTEN

Reading produced by the T50 RSS pass, before the boundary lens. It is reproduced UNCORRECTED. Keeping it is the point: without it, a changed title is just a changed title – with it, what the second pass refused becomes legible.

Steidl's crisis is a structural instance of the dilution crisis articulated in the manifesto. Steidl represents a codex—a singular, embodied system of constraints (material choices, design philosophy, curation standards) that shaped how photographs diffract into books. The publisher's overture was not algorithmic recognition but deliberate resist-

ance: careful material selection, limited editions, editorial rigor. The collapse of the photobook industry (as Steidl notes: 'Times are very bad for the book industry') reflects the platform's victory: maximum emission (infinite digital images), minimum diffraction (algorithmic curation, algorithmic recognition). Steidl's insolvency is not merely economic—it signals the erosion of the conditions under which a codex can survive. The manifesto warns: 'Go where the platform is not. The platform is the dilution engine.' Steidl's crisis is the material consequence of the dilution crisis—a publisher whose entire practice depended on resistance to algorithmic recognition cannot compete in a system optimized for it.
